Named after the great forests of Central India, the setting for the fabled Jungle Book – Mahavan is a hideaway that offers an experience like no other.


With its own Solar power plant, a minimal footprint on the ground, committed to recycling, reusing, upcycling, with over a 350000 litres of surface water runoff stored in ponds created for the purpose, wildlife friendly fencing, electric vehicles, organic farming – all in 22 acres of rewilded land, Mahavan is proudly carbon negative and devoted to being sustainable and responsible in all it does.


